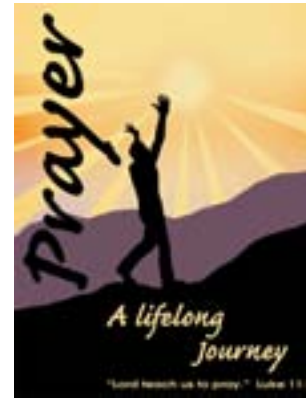
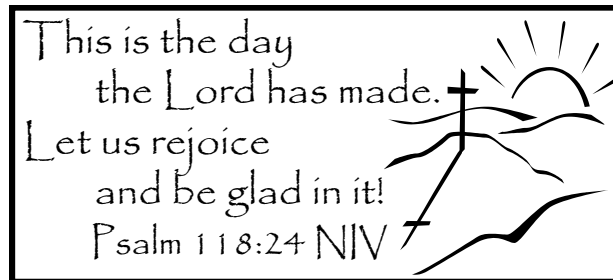

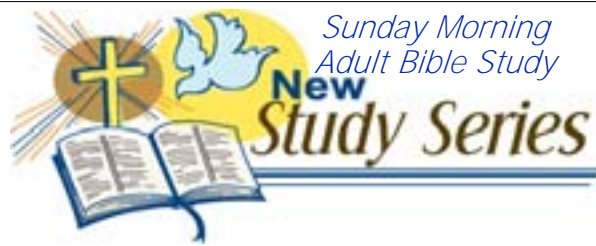

The Power of a Praying Woman (8:15)

Women usually look after the needs of others—friends, co-workers, family, and spouses—before we look after our own needs. **Our prayer lives may be just as “other”** focused. There are strengths to that but who will pray for us?

What God Does When Men Pray (8:15)

“Prayer” sounds so simple, but it isn’t always. **Through this study, we will see what God’s** Word says about prayer and learn more about how to make prayer a regular part of our lives. We will also experience ways we can grow in our personal prayer lives while praying with and for others.

Adult Information Class (8:15)

This class will give the participants an overview of the six-**chief parts of Luther’s** Small Catechism. The biblical foundation of these teachings will be a key focus of the class. During class time, opportunities to discuss the real life importance of these teachings will also be encouraged.

Our Lord’s Prayer (9:30)

We will look at the nine sections of the Lord’s Prayer, by looking into the Scriptures, the lives of real people of God as they talked to Him in prayer and as they received good things from Him—many times, even before they asked. **Together we will be refreshed by God’s care** for us and the truth that He has always been more ready to give than we are to ask.

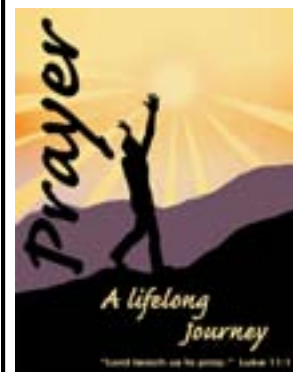
