## A MESSAGE FROM MR. HOFFMANN, PRINCIPAL The Letter

In my freshman year of college, I received an unexpected letter. It was from my grandparents' address in Missouri but the unfamiliar, elegantly flowing handwriting left me puzzled. To my astonishment, it was written by my grandfather. Prior to this, only my grandmother wrote to me, signing on behalf of both. I had always known my grandfather as a strong, silent figure who served as an MP in World War II, a Master Sergeant in the Air Force, and later a



Budweiser semi driver until retirement. I never saw him as a letter-writer, but this letter proved me wrong.

His letter came to me at a time of busyness and stress at school. His four hand-written pages sent a message I never forgot. He wrote that he was aware of what was going in my life at school. He wrote that hard work was important but to beware of "burning the candle at both ends" (his exact words). He wrote that he was thinking about me and that I should just ask if I needed anything. Then he told me he was proud of me, that he loved me, and that he was praying for me.

His letter reached deep inside of me; not only for what he said but that he took the time to write me. This big tough man, who carried things deep, and who spoke very little about his faith, took time to write me a 4-page letter about life and then faith. I still have that letter and think about it when my world gets harried.

We are coming to the tail end of the Lenten season, with Holy Week starting next week. This is a time of both sorrow and joy. It is a time set aside for looking inward at our sin and then looking outward to the cross of Good Friday. One of the things I love most about this season and Holy Week is the intentional slowdown for reflection--or what should be a slowdown.

Amid all the busyness, rushing around, and scheduled events, the Lord reaches out His hand to slow us down or perhaps send us a letter. In His written Word He tells us that He knows what is going on in our lives and He is aware of what burdens us. He tells us to breathe and then know that He is our God and He can carry the burden. He says that He is enough for us. He tells us to just ask Him if we need anything. He tells us that He loves us—so much that He put His love into action. He took His only Son and sent Him in trade for the sin that we committed—-in trade for the punishment we deserved—-in trade for our very lives. In what Christ has done for us, we now are given life eternal. His letter to us is not signed in beautiful flowing cursive but instead in big red letters that read, "PAID IN FULL".

I pray that this Lent can be a time for you to slow down, breathe, and reflect on the depth of God's love for you.
